TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR APPLICANTS OF CHAIRPERSON & MEMBERS OF CHILD WELFARE COMMITTEE (CWC)

- 1. No person shall be eligible for selection as a Chairperson/Member of the Committee, if he/she
 - (i) has any past record of violation of human rights or child rights. (Section 27 (4A) (i) of the Juvenile Justice Amendment Act, 2021)
 - (ii) has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, and such conviction has not been reversed or has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence.

 (Section 27 (4A) (ii) of the Juvenile Justice Amendment Act, 2021)
 - (iii) has been removed or dismissed from service of the Government of India or State Government or an undertaking or corporation owned or controlled by the Government of India or State Government.

 (Section 27 (4A) (iii) of the Juvenile Justice Amendment Act, 2021)
 - (iv) has ever indulged in child abuse or employment of child labour or immoral act or any other violation of human rights or immoral acts, or (Section 27 (4A) (iv) of the Juvenile Justice Amendment Act, 2021).
 - (v) is part of management of a child care institution in a District. (Section 27 (4A) (v) of the Juvenile Justice Amendment Act, 2021)
 - (vi) A person associated with an organisation receiving foreign contribution shall not be eligible to be a Chairperson or member of the Committee.
 (Rule 15 (4B) of the Mizoram Juvenile Justice Amendment Rules, 2024)
 - (vii) Any person working in the implementation of the Act in any Non-Government Organisation or any organisation, performing such functions which may cause conflict of interest in discharge of their duties as the Chairperson or member of the Committee shall not be eligible for appointment as the Chairperson and member of the Committee.

- 3. Applicant for Chairperson/Member of Child Welfare Committee (CWC) shall have to submit an Affidavit in the attached prescribed format along with the Application Form.
- 4. The Application Form and Affidavit (including documents) must be send/submit in a single pdf file through email at **mizoramicps@gmail.com** *or* in the office of concerned District Child Protection Officer, Women and Child Development **within 21 days** from the date of issue of the advertisement.
- 5. The Department have reserved the right to reject incomplete application form without any prior notice of the candidate.
- 6. Every selected Applicant for the post of Chairperson and Members of CWC must maintain his/her headquarter at the respective district as the presence is required even at odd hours or on short notice and the appointment will be cancelled if headquarter is not maintained.
