TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR APPLICANTS OF SOCIAL WORKER MEMBER OF JUVENILE JUSTICE BOARD

- 1. No person shall be eligible for selection as a member of the Board, if he/she
 - (i) has any past record of violation of human rights or child rights; (Section 4 (4) (i) of the Juvenile Justice Care and Protection of Children Act, 2015)
 - (ii) has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, and such conviction has not been reversed or has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence; (Section 4 (4) (ii) of the Juvenile Justice Care and Protection of Children Act, 2015)
 - (iii) has been removed or dismissed from service of the Central Government or a
 State Government or an undertaking or corporation owned or controlled by the Central
 Government or a State Government;
 (Section 4 (4) (iii) of the Juvenile Justice Care and Protection of Children Act, 2015)
 - (iv) has ever indulged in child abuse or employment of child labour or any other violation of human rights or immoral act.
 (Section 4 (4) (iv) of the Juvenile Justice Care and Protection of Children Act, 2015)
- 2. Applicant for member of Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) shall have to submit an Affidavit in the attached prescribed format along with the Application Form.
- 3. The Application Form and Affidavit (including documents) must be send/submit in a single pdf file through email at **mizoramicps@gmail.com** *or* in the office of concerned District Child Protection Officer, Women and Child Development **within 21 days** from the date of issue of the advertisement.
