Qualification & Age of Juvenile Justice Board Social Worker Members:

The social worker members shall not be less than thirty-five years of age and shall have at least three years of experience of working with children in the field of education, health, or welfare activities, or should be a practicing professional with a degree in child psychology or psychiatry or social work or education or sociology or in the field of law.

Emoluments:

The social worker members of the Board shall be paid not less than Rs.1500/- , per sitting which shall include sitting allowance, travel allowance and any other allowance, as the State Government may prescribe.

Role Description:

The Board shall hold its sittings twice a month in the premises of an observation home or at a place in proximity to the observation home or, at a suitable premises in any Child Care Institution meant for children in conflict with law run under the Act, and in no circumstances shall the Board operate from within any court or jail premises.
